

On September 8, 2017, the Board of Court Reporting of the Judicial Council of Georgia voted to approve the acceptance of a Georgia-specific test offered by the National Verbatim Reporters Association (NVRA) and to award a CCR license to candidates who pass this test and who otherwise qualify for a CCR license. When a court reporter passes this Georgia-specific test, they are awarded a Georgia Certificate of Completion by the NVRA. This Georgia-specific test is the same as the Certified Verbatim Reporting (CVR) exam offered by the NVRA, with the sole exception that the Georgia-specific test permits a candidate to use an audio backup. This measure will help in part ameliorate the current shortage of court reporters in Georgia while maintaining the high standards required for full certification.

Candidates wishing to take this exam must register for the Georgia Certificate of Completion test on the registration page of the city in which they choose to test.
